

# Financial Assistance Policy

Tempus offers financial assistance for patients who are in financial need to help further reduce cost.

For approved patients, Tempus will bill the patient's insurance and the patient's remaining out-of-pocket cost is outlined below. Approval for assistance is based on household income, number of people in your household and other extenuating circumstances.

Acceptable proof of income is required, such as tax documents (1040 form) from prior year, recent pay stub, or government assistance letters (social security benefit verification letter or unemployment letter).
